



# Barracuda “Cloud Ready” Program

Helping You Accelerate Your Journey to the Cloud

## Program Overview

Barracuda is offering free 90-day licenses for the Barracuda Web Application Firewall and the Barracuda NextGen Firewall in Amazon Web Services and Microsoft Azure (“cloud license”).

## Program Components

### Qualifying Product Purchases

While the program is in effect, select cloud licenses of the Barracuda NextGen Firewall and the Barracuda Web Application Firewall in Amazon Web Services (“AWS”) and Microsoft Azure will be free for the first 90-days (“trial period”).

### License Activation and Expiration

Licenses may only be activated and used by the end user customer of the cloud-based solution. Licenses must be activated within 120 days from the date the license activation code is provided (“activation period”), and will automatically become void at the end of the activation period.

Licenses will expire 90 days after activation. Barracuda may revoke the license if customer violates the terms of the associated software license or this promotion.

Customers wishing to continue using the cloud licenses after the initial trial period must purchase the license from Barracuda or an authorized partner.

### Participant Eligibility

- Only end user customers in good standing with Barracuda are eligible to participate.
- End user customers who received Barracuda products from a Managed Services Provider are also ineligible.
- Cloud licenses may only be used for end user’s internal business operations and not for resale or to provide services to third parties.
- A participant must register with Barracuda at the time of activation of the product. Licenses are non-transferrable and become void upon any transfer.
- Managed Service Providers, resellers, and distributors of Barracuda product are not eligible for this program.

## Promotion Rules, Terms, and Conditions

This program is void where prohibited by law. Barracuda reserves the right to change or cancel this promotion at any time without prior notice. The initial term of the program commences on May 24, 2017 and terminates on November 24, 2017. Barracuda may exclude customers from eligibility at its discretion. Participant is responsible for any taxes or other governmental fees or charges related to any licenses received. Barracuda is not an agent of, or responsible for, any damages or liability related to customer’s use of AWS or Azure. Except as provided herein, cloud licenses are provided as is without warranty of any kind and end user assumes all risk of use.

This program is governed by the laws of the State of California. The courts of the State of California, County of Santa Clara shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any dispute which arises under this agreement. Cloud licenses may not be used for any competitive analysis or benchmarking.
